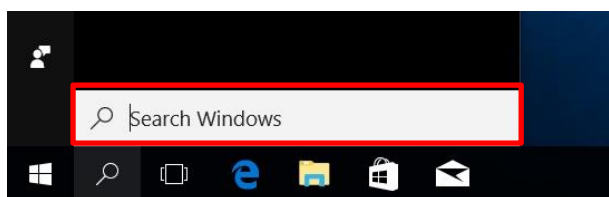
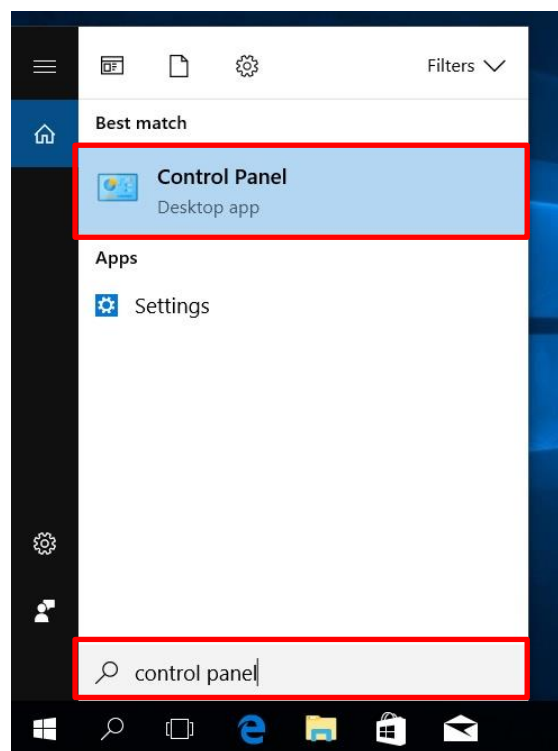


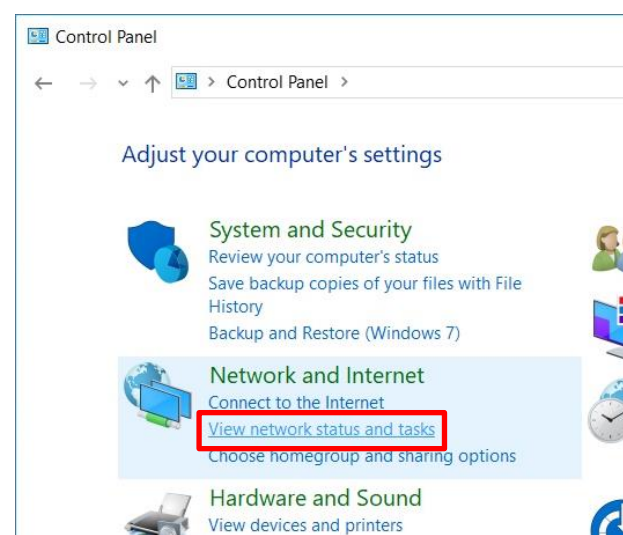
HOW TO CHANGE DNS SETTINGS



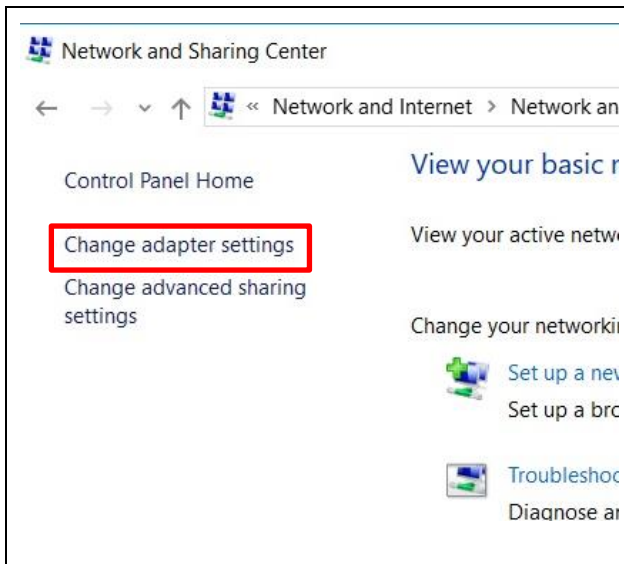
Click the search box displayed at the left bottom in the task bar and enter **Control Panel**.



Click on the **Control Panel** displayed at the top of the search box.

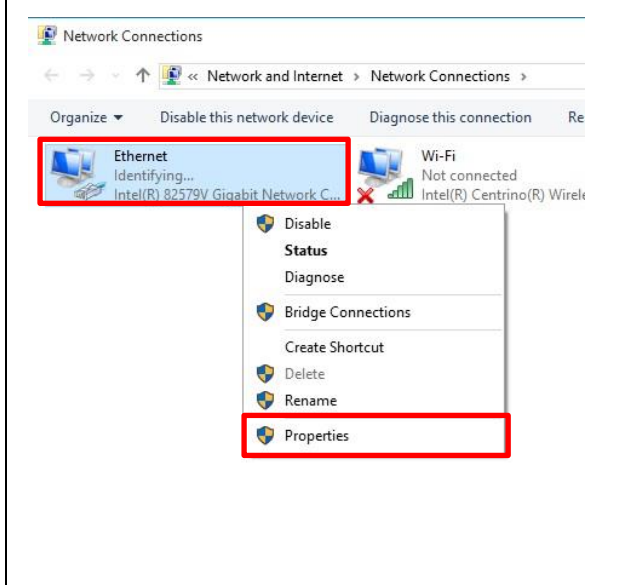


Click on **View network status and tasks** under **Network and Internet**.



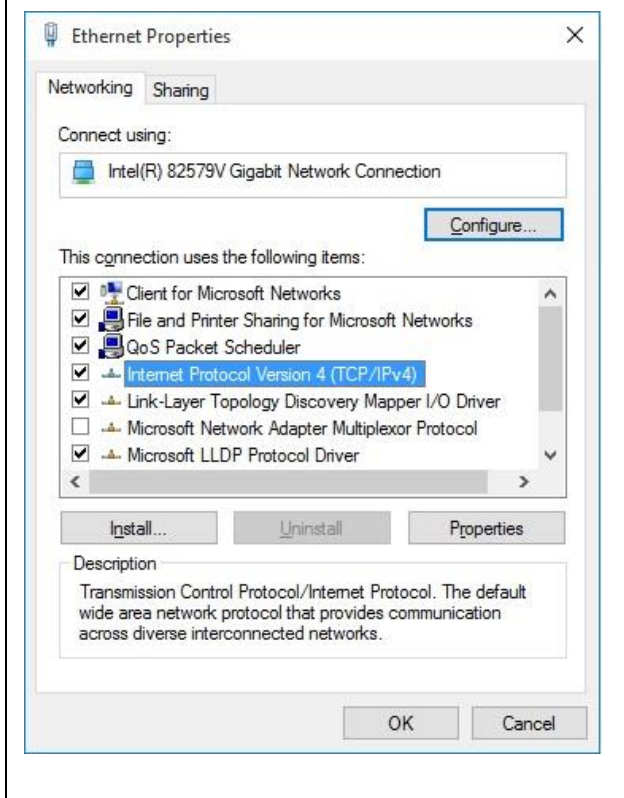
The **Network and Sharing Center** window will appear.

Click on **Change adapter settings** at the left side of the column.



The **Network Connections** window will appear.

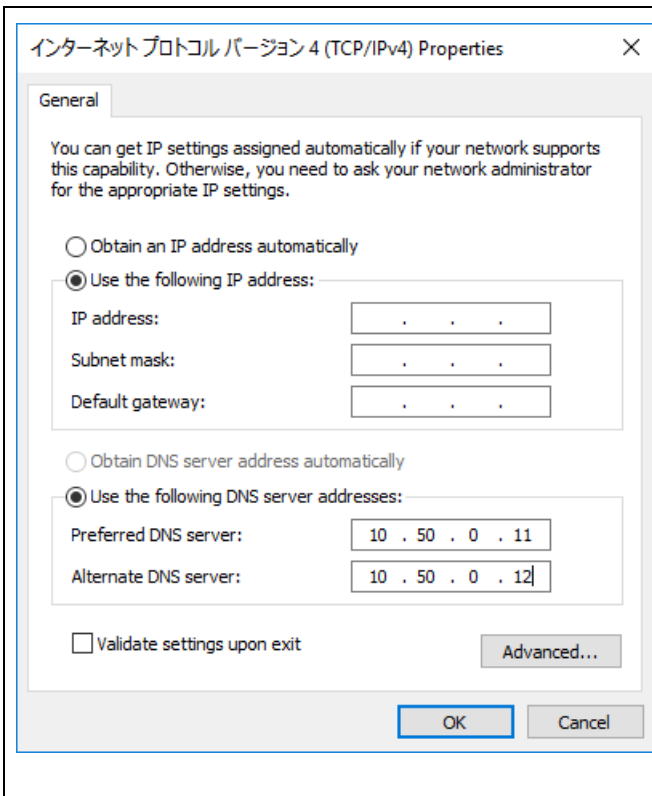
Right click on **Ethernet** and select **Properties** from the list.



The **Ethernet Properties** dialog box will appear.

Make sure the **Networking** tab within the dialog is selected. From the list which appears, select **Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4)**.

Then click the **Properties** button.

Type the following information.

[Preferred DNS server]10.50.0.11 (Primary)
[Alternate DNS server]10.50.0.12 (Secondary)

Click the **OK** button.
