


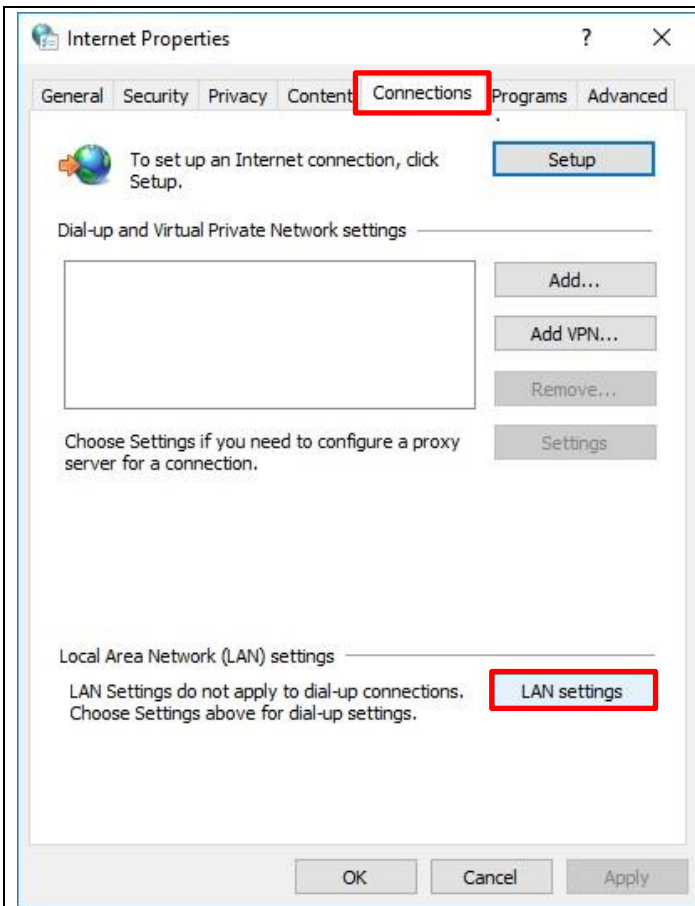


# HOW TO DELETE PROXY SETTINGS

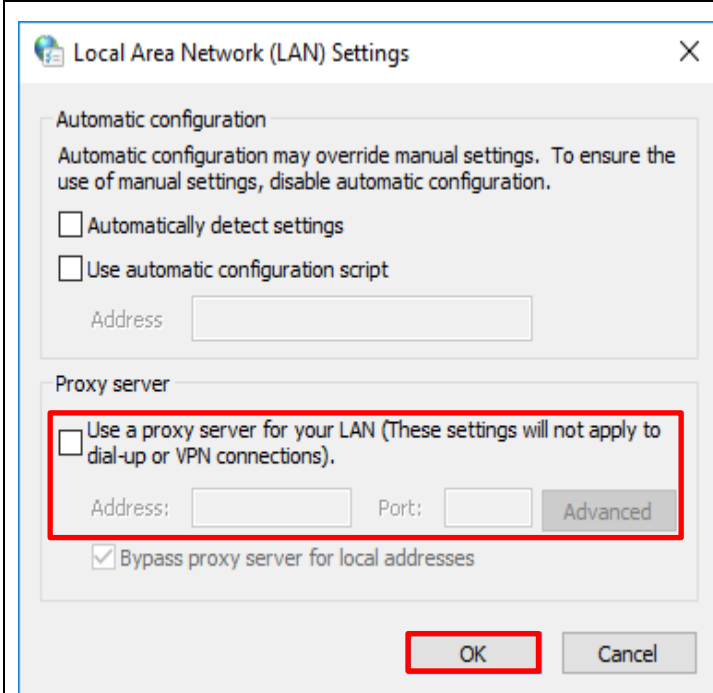

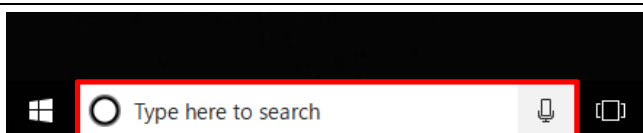
Click the **Connections** tab.

Click the **LAN settings** button.

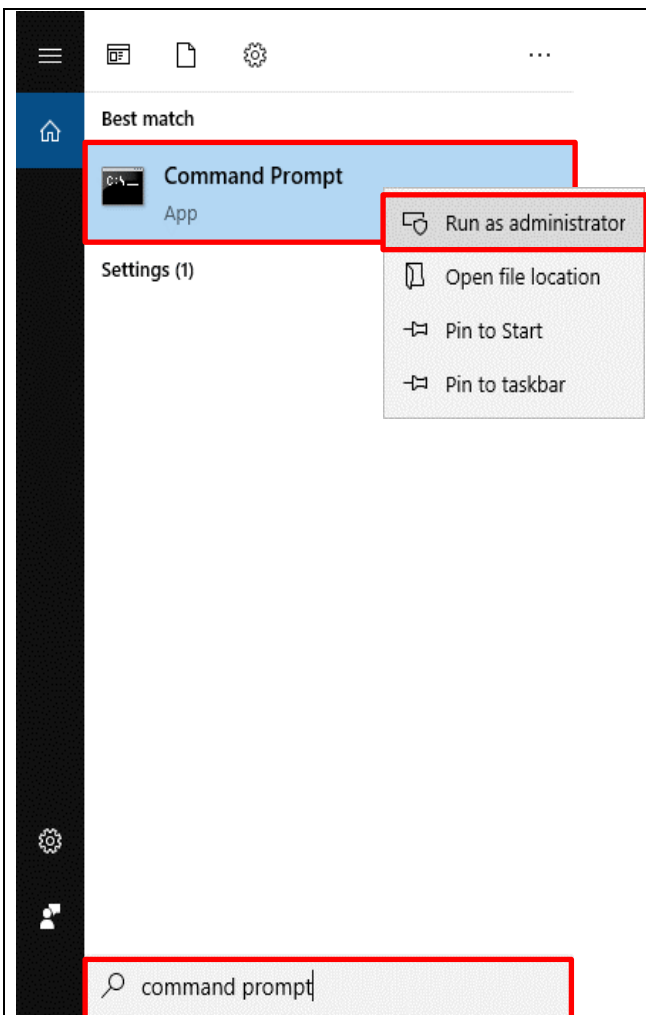


The **Local Area Network (LAN) Settings** dialog box will appear.

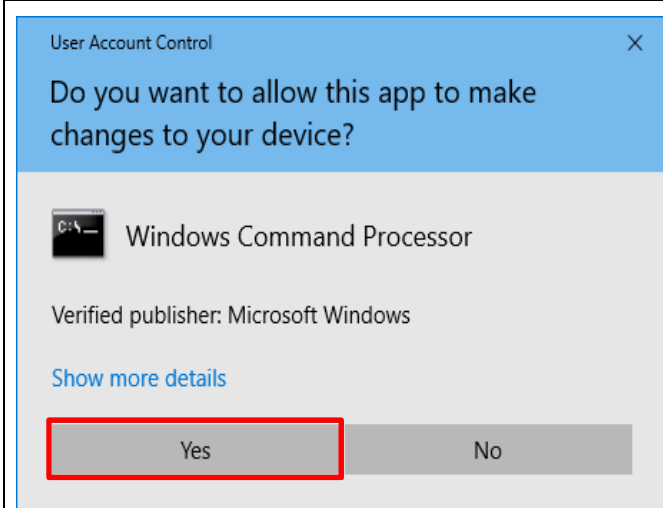
- Delete the entered information for **[Address]** and **[Port]**.

Type “**netsh winhttp show proxy**” in Command Prompt and press [**Enter**] key.

In the case that the proxy settings is displayed, type “**netsh winhttp reset proxy**” and press [**Enter**] key.

In the case that “**Direct access (no proxy server)**” is displayed, you do not need to do anything.
